

Triple Tree General Aviation Guidelines for 2012

Keeping in mind this is an event centered on safe operations for the aircraft, and providing for our guests, it is our desire to continue the Triple Tree philosophy of "Fun Fellowship and Hospitality".

Due to the expected increase in the number of guests and aircraft now enjoying the Triple Tree Full Scale Fly-In we find it necessary to adopt a few measures to insure the safety of the pilots, guests, and the aircraft.

The following will be in effect for the 2012 event. Please follow these guidelines and help our staff insure a fun, and safe, weekend for yourself, and all our visitors.

Busses will be running continuously from early in the day until late in the evening. **Please park in the designated parking areas at the gate and use the busses.**

Busses have the right of way. Please yield to them by pulling aside, and stopping, until they pass.

Golf carts, 4 Wheeler ATVs, bicycles, etc **will not be permitted in the areas of flight operations between the hours of 7 am to 7 pm.**

Personal vehicles will not be permitted in the areas of flight operations unless escorted by a staff member with the appropriate flag and markers.

You may use them in all other areas of Triple Tree property.

This does not apply to staff vehicles with the appropriate flags and markers.

All campers and private vehicles shall display an appropriate vehicle pass or camping pass at all times when driving beyond the gate house.

Camping spaces adjacent to the flight line will be limited. As always, it will be first come, first served.

No personal vehicles will be permitted beyond the bath house. Please do not leave your vehicle in an area accessible to wing camping.

The area adjacent to, and approaching the bath house (on the right) is designated handicap parking, and may be used with a state approved handicap placard.

Beginning Thursday morning, RV's will be accommodated in the areas **not accessible to wing camping.** Our staff will assist you in finding a suitable spot.

RV's in areas accessible to aircraft parking must be accompanied by an airplane. This includes the first row of the expanded wing camping area at the edge of the lake.

Vendors will be asked to remove their vehicles and trailers to a designated parking area by 9 am.

Please drive slowly, and be mindful of pedestrians and dust.
